- Everyone must have a proper size life jacket
- You are responsible for lost or damaged rental equipment
- All children under 12 and non-swimmers must wear life jackets (Ohio law)
- In case of rain, thunder or lighting, please keep paddling to designated pick-up stop
- Stay off private property
- Squirt / splash **only** the people in your group
- To prevent littering, secure all loose equipment & personal items
- Fishing is permitted on the Mohican River - with a valid Ohio fishing license
- Use litter bags and return all trash to the canoe livery
- No glass beverage containers
- Wear shoes or sandals while on the river
- Leave valuables in your car
- Be respectful of others on the river, especially those with children
- Please yield to other watercraft as you would on a highway
- Report any problems to the canoe livery
- **Alcohol and boating do not mix.** You can be fined for consumption, under age drinking, and littering.
