



# Winter in Mohican-Loudonville

*So Much To See & Do*

*Even when the weather turns chilly and the snow flies there are so many "COOL" things to do in Mohican-Loudonville*

## Mohican State Park & Forest

- Hike - 45 miles of trail - most scenic at Covered Bridge take Lyon Falls Trail - 2 miles (can be rugged) to Pleasant Hill Dam & back or take Pleasant Hill Trail - 1 mile and largely flat - back to Covered Bridge. If park roads are closed, park at Pleasant Hill Dam (County Rd 3006 off McCurdy) to hike the trail. **Print Park map from the Visitors Guide, available on-line in the Virtual Guide at [www.DiscoverMohican.com](http://www.DiscoverMohican.com)**
- Wolf Creek Run Grist Mill (*Mill closed in winter, but grounds open; parking lot off TR 629 near SR 39 & 97 & hike to mill; if weather & trail conditions permit hike to the scenic overlook viewing platform behind the Mill*)
- Mohican State Park Trails Map available for \$2 at area stores or mail order from Visitors Bureau for \$3 (*checks payable to Loudonville-Mohican CVB*)
- Mountain bike 24.5 miles around the scenic Clear Fork Gorge (*bike rental may be available at Kim's Bikes downtown*)
- Bridle Trails - bring your own horse, about 9 miles long (*horse trailer parking off SR 97 near Memorial Shrine*)
- Cross county & snowmobile - bring own equipment (*trailer parking signs off SR 97 near Memorial Shrine*)
- Visit: Clear Forge Gorge Overlook, Fire Tower, Memorial Shrine



## Malabar Farm State Park

- Enjoy 30 free interactive exhibits at the Visitors Center
- Tour 32-room Big House (*winter weekend tours only; small charge*)
- Hike trails - 12 miles of trails
- Bridle trails - bring own horse
- Cross country ski - bring own skis
- Ice skating - bring own skates
- Sledding - bring own sled
- Weekend workshops - check [www.MalabarFarm.org](http://www.MalabarFarm.org)
- Ice fishing - bring own equipment & valid Ohio fishing license; license available at local businesses

## Other Activities

- Downhill skiing at Snow Trails and Clear Fork Ski Resort (*NEW in 2012*) east of Mansfield (*rent or bring own equipment*) - ski, tube, boogie boards & more. [www.SnowTrails.com](http://www.SnowTrails.com) or [www.ClearForkSkiResort.com](http://www.ClearForkSkiResort.com)
- Walk/run on Village bike 1.5 mile path - starts at Riverside Park downtown along River & S. Market Street to Village limits at Mohican State Park & following SR 3 roadway to parking lot of Wolf Creek Grist Mill
- Shop Loudonville's quaint Victorian downtown - shops include fine furniture, Native American gifts, jewelry, 125 year old hardware store, quality shoes, antiques, gift & curio shops, art galleries, one of Ohio's only retail Avon stores, free cyber café with limited beverages, & more shops **NOTE: Some shops closed Mon. or Wed.**
- Good eats in downtown restaurants from simple fare to upscale dining
- Take in movie at 100 year old Ohio Theater downtown - offer first run feature films & live performances (*check the Ohio Theater web page for event schedule [www.OhioTheater.org](http://www.OhioTheater.org)*)
- Hunting - in season with valid Ohio hunting license (*Mohican State Forest allow in-season hunting*)
